- >Unburdened by concepts, jargon, mysterious notions or beliefs



Frictory

Key Frictors to Saying What Is:

Hungers – hidden forces that compel us to feed our cravings for emotional food (similar to Maslow needs)
For Attention, recognition, power, control, love, acceptance
Being wanted, valued, important, needed or noticed
Feeling Safe, secure, stable, belonging, connected

Identifications – with roles, titles, history, sense of self

Fear – of future consequences such as people being upset, not being liked, being ostracized, left alone

What to Call - Desire


Desire is synonymous with and yet distinct from:

Want = lack, often although not always...'heady'
Wish = fantasy and abdication of participation
Need = illusion of not being whole
Hope for = would like to have happen but not committed to action about it

Desire is deep, compelling and the coals of the fire that is expressed as Passion
